Fee Arbitration Panel

Merced County Bar Association [MCBA] plans to establish a Fee Arbitration Panel. The State Bar will provide training for volunteer arbitrators. The trainers will come to Merced to facilitate the training. There is a 6-8 week lead time to schedule the local training. The State Bar requires the County Associations to adopt guidelines for the program. Most counties adopt the state rules, but some of the larger counties modify the state rules to form their own guidelines. Whichever set of guidelines are adopted by the MCBA, the State Bar must then approve the formation of the Fee Arbitration Program.
